HVAC	High-efficiency heat pumps, chillers, unitary/split systems and PT systems; retrofits or new construction	Flat rate per unit or per ton capacity; Chillers: \$12.50-\$25/ton Other HVAC equipment: \$150-\$350/unit.
Motors and Drives	High-efficiency motors and variable speed drives (VSDs); retrofits or new construction	Motors: flat rate per unit by size, \$20-\$400/motor; Drives: \$30 per HP controlled
Streetlighting	HPS streetlights; HPS, LED or Induction OALs; LED traffic & pedestrian signals	Flat rate per fixture, \$20-\$800/fixture
Specialty Equipment	Strip curtains, ENERGY STAR refrigerators, freezers & other specialty equipment; retrofits or new construction	Flat rate per unit, \$10-\$400/measure
Custom	Supports projects not fitting into other programs; energy calculations required; retrofits or new construction	\$0.05 per kWh saved
Audits	Multi-measure audits for county and local governments and schools	\$2,000 per audit
