Non-Standard Lighting Incentives for Business Program

Commercial and industrial customers of FirstEnergy's utility operating companies in Pennsylvania – Met-Ed, Penelec and Penn Power – can now take advantage of the *Non-Standard Lighting Incentives for Business* program, which offers incentives to encourage the installation of high-efficiency lighting equipment. Costs to implement the program are recovered from FirstEnergy's commercial and industrial customers in Pennsylvania in accordance with Act 129 of 2008.

The Non-Standard program is intended for use with energy efficiency lighting projects, both new construction and retrofit, that do not fit the requirements of the Standard Lighting Incentives for Business program. Applications will require energy calculations, but various energy saving measures will potentially be eligible for incentives based on energy savings, at \$0.05 per kWh (see application form for details).

Customers may review program information and download applications to receive cash incentives for qualifying measures as described in the program's application form.

To qualify, equipment must have been purchased on or after October 28, 2009. Federal facilities can take advantage of a different program.
